## EXHIBIT A

## Policies for Use of District Trails Adopted April 18, 2023

The following rules apply to the District's trails:

- 1. **Designated Trails and Access.** Trail users must stay on existing designated trails. Access is permitted only by designated access points, identified on the map at Attachment 1. Users may not use private lots for access or trespass on private lots in the course of use of the trails.
- <u>Vehicles.</u> Trails are open to all forms of <u>non-motorized</u> transportation unless otherwise posted. Pedestrians have the right-of-way unless otherwise posted. Bicycles and other "wheeled" travelers must yield to walkers. Motorized vehicles are strictly prohibited; provided, however, that the walking trails may be used for emergency access vehicles and users shall be aware of such uses.
- 3. <u>Hours of Operation.</u> Trails may be used from dawn until dusk.
- 4. <u>Approved Programs.</u> All events, races, competitions, and other organized activities must be facilitated by the District.
- 5. <u>Safety.</u> Proper control must be maintained at all times. Speed should be restricted to safe levels appropriate for existing trail conditions. Avoid use when raining or muddy; traffic on wet trails causes damage and may be hazardous.
- 6. <u>Courtesy.</u> Users must treat District staff and fellow trail users with courtesy and respect. No violence, horseplay, or crude or disrespectful language will be tolerated. Littering and destruction of property are prohibited.
- 7. <u>Pets.</u> Pets must be kept on leashes at all time. All pet waste must be picked up and disposed of properly.
- 8. <u>Fire/Fireworks.</u> No fire or fireworks are permitted on the trails.
- 9. Vegetation. Do not disturb vegetation or wildlife.
- 10. <u>Wildlife.</u> Wildlife may be present on the trails. Users are advised to exercise caution.
- 11. <u>Penalties.</u> Violation of these Policies shall be subject to the District's Suspension and Termination of Access Rule.
- 12. <u>Addition of Trail Areas.</u> Additional trail areas and access may be designated by the Board of Supervisors.
